



## Tsar Peter The Great (1672-1725)

---

30 May 1672

Russia's Tsar Peter the Great, was born in Moscow.

1682

After the death of their elder brother, Fedor III, under the regency of their sister, Tsarevna Sophia Alexeevna, Peter I the Great (1672-1725) became Tsar of Russia jointly with his sickly half-brother Ivan V (1666-1696).

1682

The rule of Peter I the Great began, until 1725. The original stone cathedral of the Monastery of the Epiphany in Moscow was built during this time. It was built over the remnants of an earlier wooden church.

1682

In Russia a rebellion by government Streltsy regiments killed the grandfather, aunts and other relatives of Peter the Great. The Monastery of Peter the Metropolitan was reconstructed and as served as the family necropolis.

1696

The sickly half-brother to Russia's Tsar Peter the Great, Ivan V, dies leaving Peter the Great as the sole ruler of Russia.

1697

Czar Peter the Great begins tour through West-Europe.

5 Sep 1698

Russia's Peter the Great imposed a tax on beards.

1698

Russian Czar Peter the Great departs Netherlands to England.

1699

Peter the Great ordered Russian New Year changed from 1 September to 1 January.

1703

St Petersburg (Leningrad) founded by Peter the Great (1672-1725)

1710

Czar Peter the Great sets the first Russian state budget.

1721

Czar Peter the Great ends Russian-orthodox patriarchy.

1722

Czar Peter the Great begins the civil system.

28 Jan 1725

Peter the Great, King of Russia, dies in St. Petersburg.
